Size Class A = Population size over 2.5 million

Size Class B/C = Population size 2.5 million or less

The **Mountain** division includes Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Utah, and Wyoming

The **Pacific** division includes Alaska, California, Hawaii, Oregon, and Washington

Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim includes Los Angeles and Orange Counties

Phoenix-Mesa-Scottsdale includes Maricopa and Pinal Counties

Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario includes Riverside and San Bernardino Counties

San Diego-Carlsbad includes San Diego County

San Francisco-Oakland-Hawyard includes Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, San Francisco, and San Mateo Counties

Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue includes King, Pierce, and Snohomish Counties

Urban Alaska includes Anchorage and Matanuska-Susitna Borough

Urban Hawaii includes Honolulu County
